

ORDINANCE NO. 2008⁹ - 5

WHEREAS, the Town of Osgood has authority under I.C. 36-8-24 to regulate the possession and use of property within the Town of Osgood, for purposes of the public health, safety and welfare of the Town of Osgood; and,

WHEREAS, businesses which operate within the corporate limits of the Town of Osgood often utilize signage to attract business to their establishments; and,

WHEREAS, businesses which cease operation within the Town of Osgood often fail to remove their signage, which creates confusion and contributes to decay within the Town; and,


WHEREAS, the Town of Osgood has determined the need to remove said signage from businesses which cease to operate within the Town of Osgood, within a timely manner.

BE IT, THEREFORE, ORDAINED that all businesses, establishments and organizations which cease to operate within the corporate limits of the Town of Osgood shall remove all posted signage for said businesses, establishments and organizations within thirty (30) days of cease of operation. All violators of this ordinance thereof shall be subject to a fine of One Dollars (\$100) per day that said signage remains posted after said thirty (30) day period.
