ORDINANCE NO. 2011 - 5

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE
OF RATES AND CHARGES TO BE COLLECTED BY THE
TOWN OF OSGOOD FROM THE OWNERS OF PROPERTY
SERVED BY THE SEWAGE WORKS OF SAID TOWN

WHEREAS, the Town of Osgood, hereinafter "Town," has heretofore constructed and has in operation a sewage works for the purpose of collecting and disposing of the sewage of the Town in a sanitary manner and has heretofore authorized construction of improvements thereto finances in part by bonds and grants from the Rural Development (RD), an agency of the United States Department of Agriculture; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a new schedule of rates and charges to produce sufficient revenue to pay expenses of operation and maintenance, to provide funds for necessary repairs, replacements and improvements to the sewage works, and to pay the principal and interest on revenue bonds and other debt in accordance with the applicable bond ordinances.

BE IT, THEREFORE, ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Osgood, as follows:

1. For the use and the service rendered by said sewage works, rates and charges shall be collected from the owners of each and every lot, parcel of real estate or building that is connected with the Town's sanitary sewage system or otherwise discharges sanitary sewage, industrial wastes, water or other liquids, either directly or indirectly, into the sanitary sewage system of the Town of Osgood. Such rates and charges shall be payable as hereinafter provided and shall be in an amount determinable as follows:

(A) Metered Water Usage

The sewage rates and charges shall be based on the quantity of water used on or in the property or premises subject to such rates and charges, as the same is measured by the water meter there in use, subject to the minimum charge. For the purpose of

billing and collecting the charges for sewage service, the water meters shall be read monthly (or period equaling a month). The water usage schedule on which the amount of said rates and charges shall be determined is as follows:

(B) Sewer Tap Fee:

From the main sewer line to the property line or the actual cost of material and labor, whichever is greater	\$800.00 or greater
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Previous sewer ordinances are hereby amended to reflect these changes and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as required by law.
